

## Illaroo Group Camping Area User Policy, Yuraygir National Park

<b>1. General Conditions</b>
All Aboriginal cultural heritage, European heritage, flora and fauna are protected. Pets are not permitted in the group camping areas.
The NPWS reserves the right to close the IGCA at any time for operational or public safety reasons.
The NPWS reserves the right to decline campground bookings for a period of up to 2 years, to persons or groups who have previously been subject to expulsion or infringement as a result of their behaviour within NPWS managed areas within NSW.
Persons under the age of 18 years must be accompanied by a responsible adult and children must be supervised at all times.
Supervision of school groups will be in accordance with the guidelines determined by the NSW Department of Education and Training.
Only persons over the age of 18 can make a booking for the IGCA.
Maximum group size is 35 people. For informal groups a minimum of 20 people must be present to constitute a group.
For commercial tour operators a minimum of 15 people must be present to constitute a group.
Minimum length of stay is 3 consecutive nights.
<b>2. Permitted Use</b>
Maximum length of stay for any one group is 7 consecutive nights.
Commercial tour operators.
Educational groups camping as part of school activities or curriculum.
Aboriginal cultural camping.
Recognised groups such as Girl Guides and Scout groups.
Hiking groups walking the Yuraygir Coastal Walk or other long distance walking trails which past through Yuraygir NP.
Interpretive programs run by the NPWS.
Informal groups during the NSW and QLD holidays.
Wedding ceremonies will be permitted at IGCA. Ceremonies must be in accordance with the Clarence South Area Wedding Ceremonies Policy and conditions written into the wedding consent.
<b>3. Non Permitted Use</b>
Wedding receptions.
Hens, bucks or engagement parties.
Birthday parties, Christmas parties and New Year's Parties.
Groups celebrating finishing high school (Schoolies).
Rave Parties.
End of season sporting groups.
<b>4. Camp Ground Rules</b>
Tents must be erected within the camping area. Tents can not be pitched outside the area marked by the NPWS totem poles.
Camp sites must be vacated by midday. Rubbish must be taken to the rubbish bins provided at the entrance to the Illaroo Camping area. Please separate rubbish into recyclable and non recyclable materials.
Campsites, barbeque area and toilet must be kept clean. NPWS provides garbage bins on the entrance trail to Illaroo Camping area.
Fires are permitted only in the fire ring provided by the NPWS. Beach fires are not permitted.
NPWS has provided firewood at the North Illaroo campground.
No fires are permitted on total fire ban days, park fire ban days or when directed by NPWS officer.

Portable generators are not permitted.
Curfew is 10:00pm (22:00).
There is no beach access for vehicles south of the Sandon beach access.
Vehicles must be parked at all times in car park area and only enter camp area for loading and unloading of gear.
A maximum of 7 vehicles can park at the front of the IGCA.
Offensive conduct such as behave in disorderly manner in park, use insulting/offensive language, committing acts of indecency, use/be affected by prohibited drug in park is an offence of the Act.
<b>5. Bookings and Fees</b>
A hire site fee of \$50 per night (price for the whole group not per person)
Campers are required to pay the vehicle entry fee for the duration of their stay, payable to the Campground Manager, or be in possession of a valid annual pass or exemption permit. Vehicle entry fees can be paid throughout the duration of your stay or purchased beforehand.
Commercial Tour Operators (CTO) can book 12 months in advance.
Commercial activities get preference based on the need for site assurance.
Any visitors staying overnight will be regarded as occupants and will be charged with the appropriate rate.
The NPWS will attempt to accommodate the transfer of booking dates, provided that the transfer date(s) is confirmed at the time of cancellation and the new date is within the 6 month booking limit.
Fees paid for booking will not be split into multiple postponements. Multiple postponements can not be merged into one postponement. If a postponement is for less than the original amount paid, the unused portion of the payment will be forfeited by the customer.
<b>6. Postponements</b>
The NPWS will attempt to accommodate the transfer of booking dates, provided that the transfer date(s) is confirmed at the time of cancellation and the new date is within the 6 month booking limit.
<b>7. Campground Contractor Arrangements.</b>
Camping and Vehicle entry fees are payable to the CGC (see 5.6 and 5.7).
If the padlock is damaged or lost during the stay, an additional charge will be incurred to cover the replacement or repair of the key.
